Family Life – Pt.2

- Goal:** To understand the characteristics that set us apart as the “Family of God”.

- Icebreaker:** In what ways are you like your mom or dad?
- Discussion:** *1 Corinthians 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.*
1. What re-occurring conflict did your family encounter when you were growing up? How did your family resolve the conflict?
 2. How do you see the conflict you had with your family in the past effecting your life now?
 3. What do you think our Bible passage tonight means by “...that all of you agree with one another...” and “...that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.”?
 4. How have you learned to forgive those who have offended you?
 5. Share with the group ways you have learned to deal with conflict.
- Conclusion:** Our ability to deal with everyday conflict plays a large part in our relationships with one another. Our ability to forgive each other and restore relationships brings fullness to our life experiences and allows us to experience meaningful friendships.
